The house sound system utilizes self-powered loudspeakers manufactured by Meyer Sound. Recognized as a pioneer in the field, Meyer products are frequently specified for Broadway, Concert Touring, and other sound reinforcement applications where sonic accuracy, fidelity, and reliability are required. The self-powered products offer numerous advantages over conventional loudspeakers, as the built-in signal processing and amplification is specifically tailored to a particular enclosure / transducer combination. In addition, the speaker components are protected from abuse by internal limiters that unlike external signal processing cannot be tampered with. The result is an extremely reliable, high quality system that will meet the needs of the facility for years to come. The sound system has been configured as a with house front fills, balcony, under balcony fills, and subwoofers.

**Live Shows**

2 self-powered loudspeakers (Meyer CQ Series) are placed next to the proscenium opening in a left / right configuration, along with 2 Meyer Subs (USW-1P) These speakers provide coverage for the main house seating areas, including the balcony and main floor, 2 additional fills are placed under balcony, along with 4 more in balcony (Meyer MM-4).

**Cinema**

3 self-powered loudspeakers (Meyer CQ Series) are placed behind the screen in a left / center / right configuration, along with 2 Meyer Subs (USW-1P) These speakers provide coverage for the main house seating areas, including the balcony and main floor, 2 additional fills are placed under balcony, along with 4 more in balcony (Meyer MM-4).

**House Mix / Processing**

A 32 Channel mixing console (Yamaha 01V96V2) mounted in FOH has been provided for the house mix. A Soundweb DSP (Model #9088) system is configured to provide equalization, limiting, summing, and delay functions. All of the system signal processors, distribution, tie lines, and line level audio cables terminate in a set of patchbays, allowing the system to be re-configured as needed. The system also includes professional quality playback components including DVD and CD player.

**Meeting/Assembly**

A mic/ line mixer with remote control input serves as an “assembly” mixer. This allows the system to be operated from the stage without using the main mixing console. This configuration will support two microphones.

**Lobby**

All sound in theater is sent to a Lobby System Located in the Concession Supply Room. Also Located There is Volume control, 5 disks CD player. Local & Global Page Mics are also located there.

**Hearing Assistance System**

In order to comply with ADA requirements, a two-channel hearing assistance system has been installed Telex Unit, It includes the FM transmission components as well as 4 headset receivers, a battery charger, along with spare batteries. The assisted listening system allows 1 channel of audio to be broadcast throughout the facility.

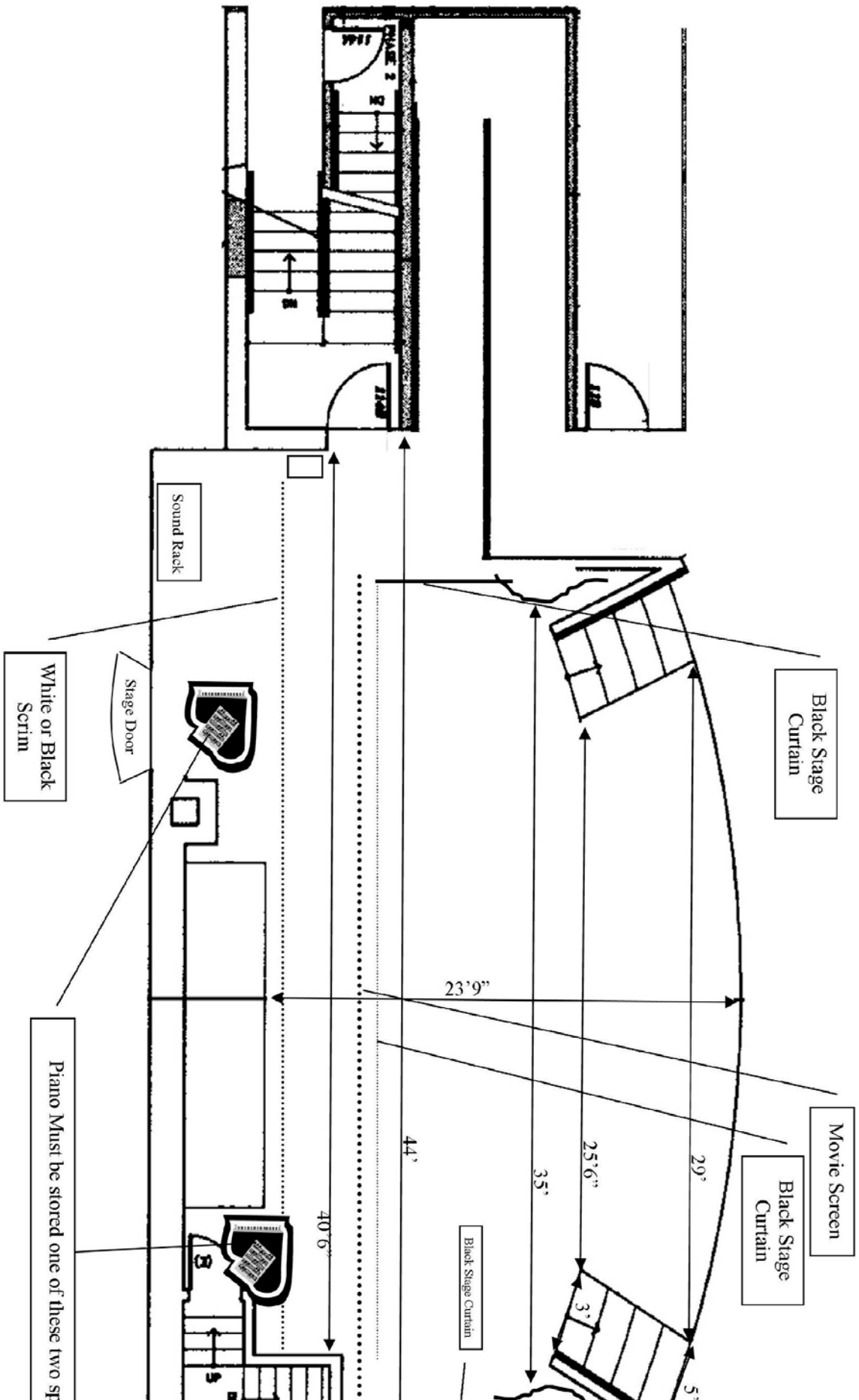
